All vaccinated , passported, neutered, micro chipped and will be ready to come to the UK in Jan 2012 !

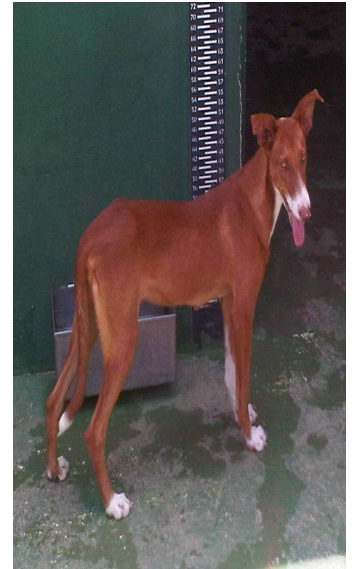
LOMBI II - Aged 5 Years (Pictured Top Left)

Woof came into the shelter 2.5 years ago. He is extremely good looking with very few white markings.

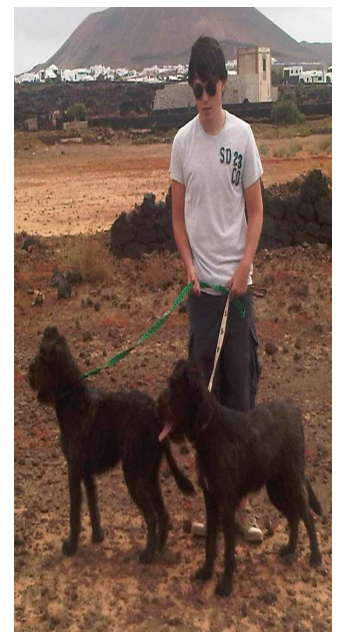
He is living in the least visited part of the shelter and consequently will never be adopted in Lanzarote.
